## Baby Quilts Giving Drive Summary

(Updated 12/7/2022)

You can use any of the ideas/patterns provided or use your own. Just remember to keep the quilts within the following ranges- NICU quilts need to be minimum $29^{\prime \prime} \times 29^{\prime \prime}$ to max of $32^{\prime \prime}$ x 32." All other baby quilts can be any length \& width up to throw size. *Note sizes on quilts below for a good reference.

Guild members may turn in their finished quilts at any guild function. Feel free to show your quilts during Show \& Tell. If I am not in attendance, please give to Norine Oyasato or any board member. Members and non-members may also drop off their quilts at any of the following locations at any time:

Wherever you are turning in quilts please pin a note with your name to each quilt. Please do not deliver quilts to hospital.
This is an ongoing project that the guild has. I deliver them to Kapiolani a few times a year.

- Once you look over the list of patterns and decide on which quilt(s) you'd like to make just email me for the directions. Most patterns are a standalone document. Some come with others. Most of the quilts I have a photo of on file so if you're visual like me you may request the pic.
- Please do not attach any business tags/labels or embroidered company names on your quilts.
- If you have any questions on the patterns just ask.
- We are always looking for fabric donations. Kids novelty prints, solids and larger pieces for backings (1 yard pieces or larger) are especially needed. Fabric must be clean, 100\% cotton.
- Batting- We will gladly take batting donations. Large pieces left over from your longarmer that can be joined are perfect. 80/20 blend, cotton, wool or bamboo. No poly.
- If you need fabric, backing and/or batting to complete your quilts for donation please contact me. We will also have a Baby Quilt Supplies table set up at the guild meetings a few times a year.

- 1 yard cotton fabric

- Coordinating thread
- Creative Grids Corner Grid or round plate
\#2 Fat Quarter Giving Quilt (31" X 36")
- 4 coordinating Fat Quarters
- $2^{\prime \prime}$ X WOF strip of coordinating solid
- Backing- 1 yard
- Batting- $36^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$
- Binding- 4 strips
\#3 Square in a Square (37" x 37")
- 1 Charm Pack-5" squares (42)
- 1 yd. solid or low volume (background)
- Backing- $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yard
- Batting- $42^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$
- Binding- 5 strips


## \#4 Sideways Bricks (36" X 38")

- $254^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ print rectangles You can use scraps here or cut up Fat Quarters. One FQ will give you 10 blocks.
- $254^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ " solid or low volume rectangles (all 25 rectangles should be the same fabric)
- Backing- $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yard
- Batting-40" X42"
- Binding- 4 strip


## \#5 Strip Your Stash Baby (31" X 36")

- $4621 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ assorted strips
- Backing- 1 yard
- Batting- $36^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{\prime \prime}$
- Binding- 4 strips
\#6 Charm Square Quilt (32" x 36")
- $285^{\prime \prime}$ assorted charm squares
- $5 / 8$ yard solid, tonal or low vol
- Backing- 1 yard
- Batting- 36 " $\times 40^{\prime \prime}$
- Binding- 4 strips
\#7 Afternoon Delight ( 36 12" X 41")
- $104 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF (all different) another super stash buster! (you can use 10 Fat Quarters too!)
- Backing- $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yard
- Batting- $42^{\prime \prime} \times 46^{\prime \prime}$
- Binding- 5 strips


## \#8 Sweet Sixteen ( 32 "x 40 ")

- $16021 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (can use 4 mini charm packs (they don't have to be all the same) or various scraps)
- $1 / 2$ yard background fabric (low volume, tonal or solid)
- Backing- $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yard
- Batting-37" x $45^{\prime \prime}$
- Binding- 4 strips


## \#9 Here Kitty Kitty ( $\mathbf{3 2 " X} \mathbf{~ X ~ 3 " ) ~}$

- $215^{\prime \prime}$ squares
- $215^{\prime \prime}$ complimentary solid, low volume or tonal
- $3 / 8$ yard border fabric
- Backing- 1 yard
- Batting- $36^{\prime \prime} \times 41^{\prime \prime}$
- Binding-4 strips

- $186^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ assorted print blocks (you can do a theme-superhero, novelty, flowers)

- Backing- Just a hair over a yard
- Batting-37" x 37"
- Binding- 4 strips
\#11 Take Five Baby Quilt (30" x 30")
- $\underline{25} 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 \prime$ " (these can be all cute prints or a mix of prints \& solids, almost solids, tonals or low volumes)
- Backing- 1 yard
- Batting- 35" x 35"
- Binding- 4 strips
\#12 Strip Your Stash Mini (32" x 32")
- $322 \frac{112 \prime \prime}{2} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips (assorted kids
- prints)
- $3221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips (solid or low volume- mixed or all the same)
- Backing- 1 yard
- Batting-36" x 36"
- Binding- 4 strips


## \#13 Framed Mini (32" x 32")

- 1 Fat Quarter (fun, happy, novelty)
- $31 / 4$ yard pieces that compliment FQ
- Backing- 1 yard
- Batting- 36" x 36"
- Binding- 4 strips


## \#14 Charm Square Mini (32" x 32")

- 25 assorted pretty 5" squares
- 24 solid or low volume 5" squares
- Backing- 1 yard
- Batting-36" $\times 36^{\prime \prime}$
- Binding- 4 strips
\#15 Fat Quarter Giving Quilt-Mini (31" x 32 1/2")
*If you want this pattern, request \#2 as it's
included on that page.
- 4 coordinating Fat Quarters
- $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip of coordinating solid
- Backing- 1 yard
- Batting-36" $\times 41^{\prime \prime}$
- Binding- 4 strips


## \#16 Rail Fence Mini (33" x 33")

- 9-12 Jelly Roll Strips (2 $1 / 2$ " x WOF) or 9$1221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips from yardage.
- $186^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ squares in a complimentary solid, tonal or low volume
- $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ quilting ruler if you have one
- Backing \& Batting-39" x 39"
- Binding- 4 strips
\#17 Easy Peasy Rail Fence ( 36 ½" x $361 / 2 "$ )
- $1 / 2$ yard focus fabric
- $1 / 4$ yard of two different solids that compliment your focus fabric
- 5/8 yard light neutral-white, off white
- Backing-1 $1 / 4$ yard
- Batting
- Binding-5 strips
- $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cutting grid- not required by makes it easy to trim blocks.
\#18 Big Block Rail Fence ( 40 ½" x $401 / 21$ )
- 1 yd focus fabric
- $1 / 4$ yard of three different solids that compliment your focus fabric
- Backing \& Batting-45" x 45"
- Binding- 5 strips


## \#19 Big Block Rail Fence Mini (30" x 30")

- Five $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ solid fabric
- Sixteen assorted $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3 "$ fabrics
- Backing \& Batting 35" $\times 35^{\prime \prime}$
- Binding- 4 strips
